

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (STRO14889) affecting **A) C381 Ferry Road** from its junction with A146 Norwich Road for 50 metres northwards ("Road A") and **B) C380 Birch Way** from its junction with A146 Norwich Road for 10 metres southwards ("Road B") in the Parish of Thurton to facilitate sign replacement works, the Roads A and B will be temporarily closed/restricted (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be on the 4th August 2026, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 15th September 2026 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: **Road A)** A146 Norwich Road, Ashby Road, Mill Road, Hall Road, Church Road, Chapel Road, Chapel Lane, Spong Lane, Ferry Road. **Road B)** Clockwise: A146 Norwich Road, Nursery Road, Langley Road, Birch Way. Anticlockwise: Hall Road, The Street, A146 Norwich Road (Ashby St. Mary, Thurton, Carleton St. Peter).

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Norfolk County Council.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Roads A and B where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 15th September 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

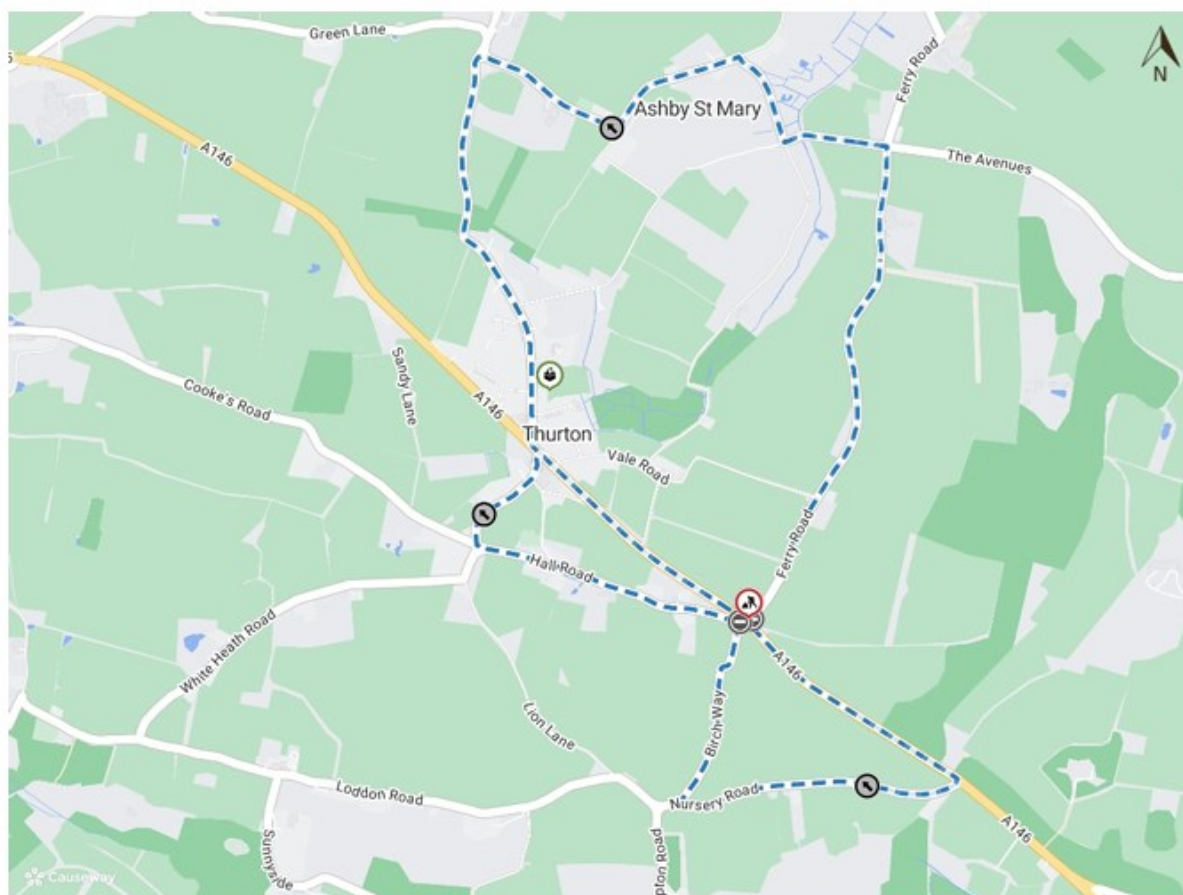
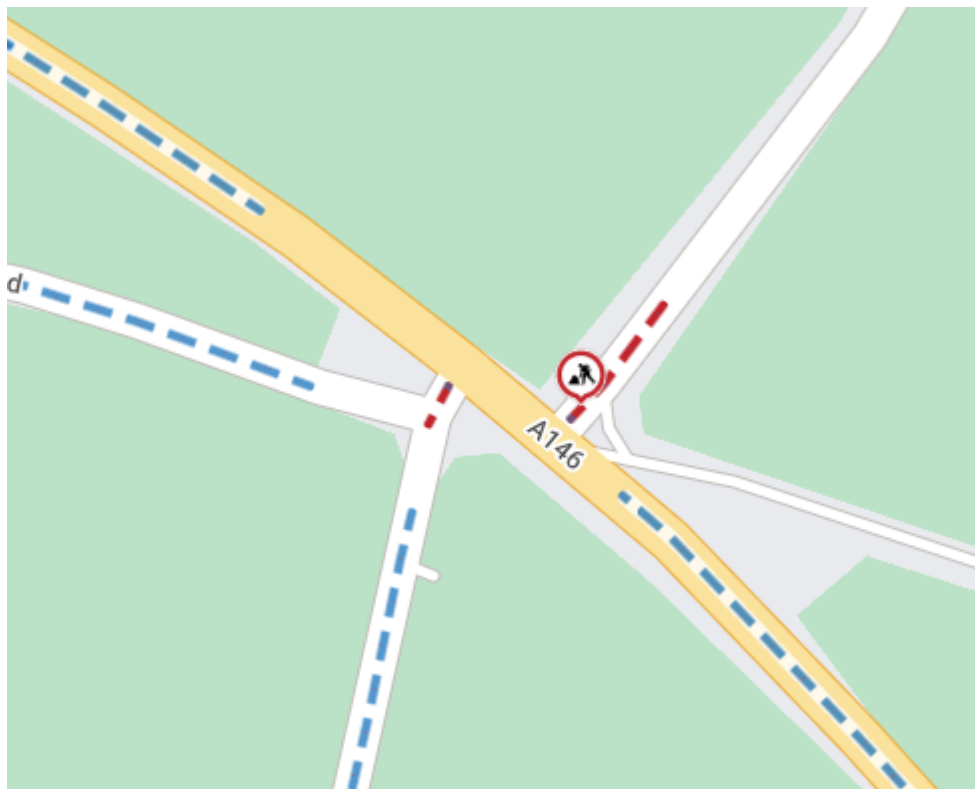
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
